Growers and consultants share their own experiences with Strada® herbicide during the 2008 rice-growing season.

"I had a 50-acre field in crawfish in 2007 and then I let it sit fallow, so I knew I would have tremendous jointvetch pressure. I was mainly after jointvetch and got very good control. It also took out large nutsedge that was seeding."
